## Paper Products

### Acceptable

Newspaper, Magazines, & Catalogs  
Corrugated cardboard  
Clean pizza boxes, telephone books  
Grey chipboard: cereal & shoe boxes  
Envelopes, junk mail, paper bags  
Pop/Beer cartons, carbonless forms

### Unacceptable

Disposable diapers, tube rolls  
Photographs, greeting cards  
Food Encrusted pizza boxes  
Cereal box liners, pet food bags  
Slick coated frozen food boxes  
Tissue paper, wrapping paper

## Clean Metal

### Acceptable

Rinsed tin/steel food containers  
Aluminum foil, pie pans, trays cans  
Metal jar lids  
Aluminum window frames, chairs

### Unacceptable

Paint and aerosol containers  
Pesticides and chemical containers  
Iron, steel and batteries  
Car parts, oil filters

## Plastic (Recycling symbol types 1-7)

### Acceptable

Milk and juice jugs  
Margarine and ice cream tubs  
Yogurt cups  
Pop and Water Bottles  
Cooking oil containers  
Shampoo Bottles  
Lotion bottles  
Dish and liquid soap bottles  
Bleach and detergent containers  
Household cleaning containers

### Unacceptable

Plastic bags  
Motor oil containers  
Pesticides and chemical containers  
Plastic with out a recycling symbol  
Prescription bottles  
Unsanitary containers  
Styrofoam  
Medical Supplies

## Glass

**Glass is not accepted in the co-mingled recycling program**
