Park Board Meeting Minutes October 20, 2025

The October 20, 2025, Cascade Park Board meeting was called to order by Chairman Rausch at 5:00 p.m. at the Cascade City Hall with Orr, Rausch, McLees, and Hailey Rausch answering roll. Manternach was absent.

Motion Orr, second Hailey to approve the agenda with moving item #7 before #4 – all ayes, motion carried.

Members of the Cascade Pickleball Group were in attendance. Terry & Jan Frasher addressed the Park Board concerning the approval of the rules and court signs at the pickleball courts in Oak Hill Park. The group had Big River draft signs, but they did not align with the branding colors or font that was approved in 2023. Hailey discussed some points regarding the signs with the group. She offered to do a proof of what it should look like using the branding colors and font and email it out to Terry & Jan. The group was agreeable to this. Motion Hailey, second McLees to approve the signs with amending the rule and court signs that Big River drafted and drafting it to follow the branding colors and font of the City- all ayes, motion carried.

The Cascade Pickleball Group was also wanting approval of the shade pavilion. The Park Board received photos of one that replicates what they want to construct. Motion Hailey, second Orr to approve the shelter plans – all ayes, motion carried. Hailey commented that it was a pleasure working with them on the courts and it is nice to see the courts so busy.

Motion McLees, second Hailey to approve the meeting minutes from September 15, 2025 - all ayes, motion carried.

Motion Orr, second Hailey to approve the August & September 2025 financials – all ayes, motion carried.

Cascade WIN class wants to install a Little Library in Oak Hill Park. They marked a spot for the location, which is near the Oak Hill Park sign. Motion McLees, second Orr to approve the location with it being painted blue or natural wood – all ayes, motion carried.

Other business included installing a camera in Oak Hill Park, getting some lights near the courts, playground equipment, and another location. It was mentioned that we could lay some street millings for a temporary parking lot and that people are still driving through even with barriers. The City Administrator will investigate these matters.

Motion Orr, second McLees to adjourn the Park Board meeting at 5:51 p.m. – all ayes, motion carried.
